English language and literature	All folders to be completed and handed in by January in year 11
Mathematics	No coursework all marks come from examinations
Science	All controlled assessment will be completed in school and will be continuously assessed. There is an ISA timed practical test that will take place in class.
Physical Education	<p>50% of marks come from practical components. The marks are decided by continual assessment. 10% of the marks come from an oral observation and analysis task on the moderation day.</p> <p>There is also a small piece of written coursework which contributes 10% to the health related exercise component</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Completion date : Feb half term of year 11</p>
Religious Education	No coursework all marks come from examinations
Art & Design	All controlled assessment to be completed by January of year 11 (60% of final mark). Preparation for the final examination must be completed by March in year 11.
German	All controlled assessment (oral and written work) to be completed by March in year 11
ICT	<p style="text-align: center;">ICT Deadlines</p> <p>Year 10 – controlled task worth 60%. Task involves solving the ICT problems for an organisation. 22½ hours task with the work spread out between September and March.</p> <p>Year 11 – controlled task worth 60%. Task involves creating a multimedia website for an organisation. 22½ hours task with the work spread out between September and March.</p>
History	<p>Controlled assessment due October 1/2 term in year 11</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Year 10</p> <p>controlled assessment worth 25% spread out over the year and completed by Easter of that year</p>
Geography	<p>Year 11 pupils will complete one controlled assessment in the Autumn term worth 25% of the outcome.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Completion deadline : Before the Christmas holidays</p> <p>Year 10 have no controlled assessment or examinations.</p>

<p>Design Technology: Resistant Materials, Graphics, textiles, Product Design</p>	<p>All pupils will complete a Controlled Assessment Task (CAT) which will contribute to 60% of their overall grade. Pupils will be asked to choose a design brief from a list set by the WJEC and design and manufacture a product that overcomes the brief. The CAT consists of 15 A3 pages which must be completed under teacher supervision.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Deadline for CAT is February half term.</p>
